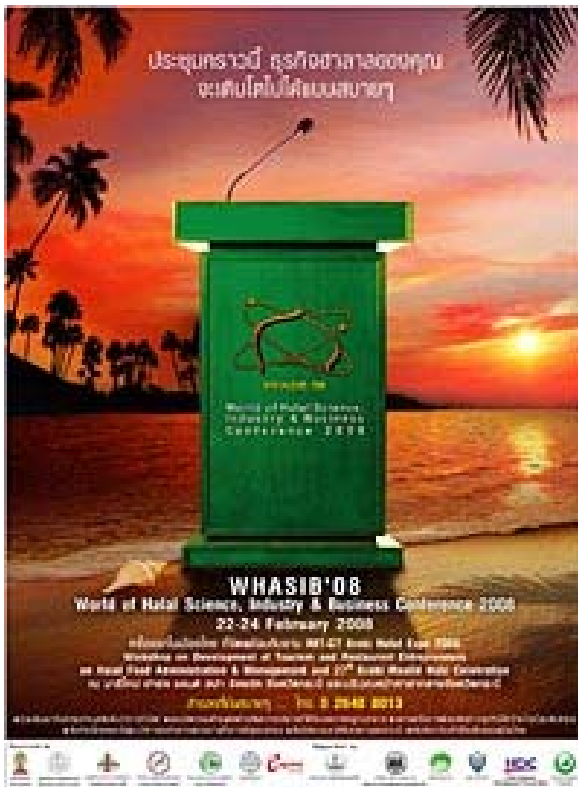

i) Terms of Reference and Objectives of the WG-HAPAS agreed at 2nd WG-HAPAS :

- a) To consolidate halal integrity in the food, non-food products and related services through the development of standards, certification, religious security, consumer protection and standard methods of analysis in order to increase the potential of IMT-GT region as competent trade area for global halal trade.

- b) To intensify human resource development activities through the training of halal entrepreneurs and extension services to stakeholders in halal industry;
- c) To facilitate trading halal product and services among IMT-GT countries and between IMT-GT countries with other regions by strengthening areas along value chains
- d) To involve religious authorities in the Meeting of the Working Group

ii) New Projects Proposals in 2nd WG-HAPAS

- ❑ Thailand proposed new projects:
 - Integrated ICT Halal Superhighway;
 - The Training Course on Halal Forensic Laboratory;

- ❑ Thailand welcomed participants from IMT-GT member countries to join both programmes.
